

Awnlux Standard Awning Technical White Paper

Introduction

Welcome to the Awnlux Standard Awning Technical White Paper. This document presents Awnlux's engineering approach to addressing persistent RV awning operational challenges through engineering innovation and high-quality materials. Awnlux standard awnings are divided into three core series: Full Cassette, Roll-Out, and Slide Topper, comprehensively meeting the needs of different vehicle types and usage scenarios.

RV awnings are critical components continuously exposed to environmental forces and face a series of predictable degradation patterns and operational challenges. Based on field experience and industry feedback, Awnlux has identified the following core pain points and provides targeted engineering solutions:

- **Material & Structural Durability:** Addressing common issues in traditional awnings such as arm deformation, fabric wear, and reduced stability during long-term outdoor use, Awnlux utilizes high-strength 6063-T5 aluminum alloy frames combined with 450gsm six-layer PVC vinyl fabric featuring waterproof and UV-resistant properties. This engineered material and structural design significantly enhances overall rigidity, ensuring stable tension performance during daily operation, thereby improving long-term durability and delivering reliable shading across various outdoor environments.
- **Strength & Weight Optimization:** Many RVs need to minimize weight without sacrificing structural integrity. Models like the W5510 and W5810 (European style) feature lightweight structural designs, reducing vehicle payload while maintaining industrial-grade durability through proprietary aluminum alloy compositions.
- **Multi-Vehicle Compatibility Matrix:** Addressing the integration and installation challenges caused by significant variations in vehicle body structures, roof configurations, and mounting interfaces across different RV and recreational vehicle categories, Awnlux offers a diversified product portfolio with application-oriented awning solutions. These include the Roof Mount (W5800) for high-roof vans such as Sprinter and Iveco platforms, the Rack Mount (W5300T) for 4WD vehicles and SUVs, alongside dedicated solutions for Class A/B/C motorhomes and travel trailers. This vehicle-specific approach helps improve installation compatibility, simplify integration, and support a wider range of vehicle applications.
- **Batch Performance Consistency:** Batch-to-batch variations plague supply chains. Awnlux follows the ISO 9001 quality management system and employs standardized manufacturing processes to ensure every product meets the same high-performance standards.
- **From Shade to “Smart Space”:** RV user demands have evolved beyond simple shading. Awnlux integrates Bluetooth app control, COB LED lighting, and smart wind sensors, aiming to transform the awning into a core component of the modern smart RV ecosystem.
- **Global Compliance & Eco-Standards:** To align with increasingly stringent environmental requirements in Europe and North America, Awnlux ensures full

compliance with RoHS and REACH regulations, while utilizing eco-friendly powder coatings and lead-free electronic components.

2. Three Core Series Analysis

Awnlux standard awnings are divided into three core series based on structure and functional focus. Full Cassette and Roll-Out models are universal awnings suitable for wall or roof mounting; Slide Toppers are specifically designed to protect the top of slide-out structures.

- Full Cassette Awning
 - Design Features: When retracted, the fabric and mechanical arms are completely stored inside a full aluminum alloy shell, forming a closed protection.
 - Advantages: Highest level of fabric protection against UV, branch scratches, and rain/snow erosion; streamlined appearance with low wind resistance.
 - Usage Scenarios: Full-time RV living, frequent highway driving, extreme weather environments.
 - Representative Models: W5900 (Heavy-duty wall mount), W5500 (Mid-size wall mount), W5800 (Roof mount), W5520 (Sunmax Compact wall mount), W5510 (European lightweight wall mount), W5810 (European lightweight roof mount).
- Roll-Out Awning
 - Design Features: Fabric rolls directly onto the roller tube, partially exposed when retracted, with a relatively simple structure.
 - Advantages: High cost-effectiveness, simple and reliable structure, easy to maintain and replace fabric; can provide a larger shade area.
 - Usage Scenarios: Weekend camping, seasonal camping, users seeking cost-effectiveness and lightweight solutions.
 - Representative Models: W5600 (Manual roll-out), W5700 (Electric roll-out).
- Slide Topper

- Design Features: Specifically designed for the top of RV slide-out rooms, automatically deploying and retracting with the slide-out.
 - Advantages: Prevents leaves, water pooling, and debris from falling onto the slide-out roof, protects slide-out seals, and prevents mechanism jamming.
 - Usage Scenarios: All Class A, Class C, and travel trailers equipped with slide-out rooms.
 - Representative Models: W5250 (Lippert/Solera compatible), W5280 (Dometic/Carefree compatible), W5270.
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3. Extreme Environment Performance

RV awnings must maintain structural integrity and functionality across various extreme climates. Awnlux standard awnings are engineered with rigorous environmental tolerance.

- Extreme Temperature Tolerance (-20°C to 60°C): Awnlux standard awnings are designed with an operating temperature range of -20°C to 60°C. The 13.5oz 6-layer PVC fabric retains flexibility and resists cracking at -20°C; at 60°C, the high-quality outdoor fabric resists degradation, and the aluminum alloy shell effectively reflects heat to protect the stored fabric inside.
 - High Altitude, High UV: High altitude environments have intense UV radiation. High-quality outdoor fabrics are UV-treated (colour fastness to light rating 3-4), resisting fading under strong sunlight. The Full Cassette series provides 100% UV shielding when not in use; even for Roll-Out series, the fabric's anti-UV coating effectively extends lifespan.
 - Tropical Humidity (>90% RH): The fabric features a hydrostatic head water resistance of >5000 mmH₂O, is completely non-absorbent, mildew-resistant, and anti-corrosive. The aluminum alloy frame uses anti-corrosion coatings, adapting to high-salt, high-humidity coastal environments.
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4. Fatigue Endurance Testing

Awnlux's fatigue testing is primarily used to verify the durability performance of awnings during high-frequency deployment and retraction.

Awnlux's standard awning series (including roll-out and full cassette models) have passed **7,000 cycles** of fatigue testing. Calculated at 2 uses per day, this corresponds to an approximate **10-year** lifecycle.

- Daily open/close cycles: Full Cassette recommended. For scenarios requiring almost daily deployment and retraction, the full cassette design offers superior durability. Verified by 7,000 fatigue test cycles, its mechanical structure is highly reliable. The full cassette completely stores the fabric inside the shell after each retraction, reducing environmental exposure when not in use.
- Weekend warrior trips: Both designs are capable. Weekend camping is typically intermittent, with annual usage frequency far below the 7,000-cycle endurance limit, so both roll-out and full cassette models meet basic needs.
- Frequent site hopping & Rental fleets: Full Cassette recommended. Rental fleet users typically require higher fault tolerance. The full cassette design automatically protects the fabric when retracted, reducing damage risks from improper operation. Electric versions (e.g., W5700) feature emergency manual cranks, enhancing overall reliability.
- Extreme weather deployment: Full Cassette recommended. The full cassette provides extra protection via the aluminum shell when retracted, better suited for complex environments like high winds and heavy rain. Awnlux recommends retracting the awning during strong winds and rain (typically safe up to force 5 winds); electric versions offer optional wind sensors for automatic retraction.

Furthermore, multiple models integrate **COB LED lighting**, providing efficient and uniform outdoor illumination.
- **Flexible Production & Deep Customization:** Awnlux possesses strong OEM/ODM capabilities to meet personalized market demands. Customization options include: **Logo customization** (laser engraving or metal stickers), **Frame color** (standard black/white), **Fabric color** (9 popular colors available), **Size customization**, and **Bracket customization** (for special vehicles). Awnlux production is highly flexible, with small-batch orders under 50 sets delivered rapidly within 7-10 days.
- **Global Compliance & Eco-Standards:** Products have passed comprehensive international certification systems, ensuring smooth entry into global markets. Acquired certifications include **CE** (European market access), **LVD** (Low Voltage Directive), **ICR**, and **ISO 9001** quality management system certification. Environmentally, Awnlux strictly complies with **RoHS** and **REACH** regulations, ensuring products are free of hazardous substances like lead, mercury, and cadmium, and utilizes eco-friendly powder coatings.

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
